Instagram @fpccovington Easter is Resurrection Day! It is a high holy day of remembering what God has done in, is doing, and will do in Christ Jesus. It is a day of celebrating that we are called to be an Easter People. **Easter represents new beginnings, life after death, light in the darkness, and newfound energy in our journeys of discipleship.**

This Easter we get to arrive at the empty tomb while it is still dark. An Easter Sunrise experience gives us an opportunity to participate in Resurrection joy breaking through the darkness. If you have not attended an Easter Sunrise service, I



encourage you to try it this year. Then, I invite you to come back at 11:00am as we raise our voices and sing praises to the Living God!

On Easter morning we will read John's account of Jesus' resurrection. You are encouraged to read our scripture and ponder it in your heart. (John 20:1-18)

Together we will ask ourselves the questions Jesus

asks Mary, "why are you weeping? Who are you looking for?" We will hear Mary's eyewitness account of the empty tomb and join her in announcing, "I have seen the Lord!"

We will be called by name and sent out to proclaim the good news of the Risen Lord!

Six months ago, at the beginning of the fall of 2022, a group of church members and our pastors took a pilgrimage to Montreat, NC. It is a beautiful place with gorgeous mountain scenery and lots of interesting people from all over the country, all of whom are doing a variety of things, but at the heart of all the things that are happening in Montreat are relationships...relationships with each another and relationships with our Creator.

We have just returned from yet another pilgrimage to Montreat to continue our work with the leaders of the Thriving Congregations Initiative. This work has been made available by a grant that Pastor Neeley discovered through a relationship that she had with the staff at Montreat. Relationships are at the heart of who we are as a people and they make opportunities like this one possible!

You are probably aware of the work we have been doing for the past several months if you have experienced a one-on-one conversation with a team member or witnessed a team member sitting quietly in a corner taking notes while the rest of us do what we do as a church. We are in the process of learning more deeply about who we are, what weighs our hearts, what our community needs and how we can best deploy our resources to become the church that truly is the hands and feet of Christ in the world.

In the days ahead we will continue having one-on-one conversations so **if you haven't yet enjoyed one of these discussions, contact Dan Walden** at 404-405-3559 and we'll get you hooked up with a team member at your convenience. We will also begin digging into the history of Newton County and Covington

so we can understand our historical context. And soon we will begin organizing "House Meetings" to bring folks together over these same topics. So be on the lookout for your opportunity to have your voice heard. We are just 6 months into a two year process, so we have lots to learn from each other.




