#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

The Seminary Intern is accountable to the Senior Pastor.

- Engage the curiosity of our children, youth, and young families by creatively communicating weekly opportunities.
- Imagine, Plan, and Implement ministry opportunities in the area of Faith Formation: energizing Small Groups/Sunday School (Children, Youth, Young Adult and Adult)  
Children and Youth Ministry Activities including Intergenerational Opportunities
- As a valued teammate as well as a student, participate in Staff team meetings and Worship planning.
- Share in responsibilities of Pastoral Care with Senior Pastor
- Assist with Communication and Marketing team.
- Participate in a variety of areas of ministry to explore your sense of call to ministry.

**Dates:** May 2022- August 2022 (Summer)

**Hours:** Full – time (40 hours a week) / Sundays required.

**Honorarium:** A stipend up to \$3200 is offered. Assistance with housing/travel is available.
