Host to Family Promise Families



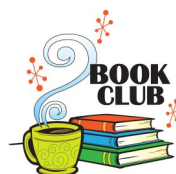
We will host the week of August 25-September 1

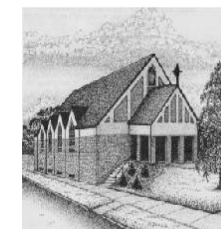
