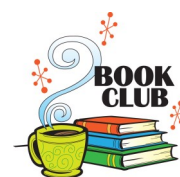

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

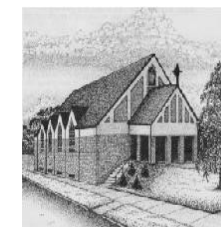
