ASSURANCE OF PARDON

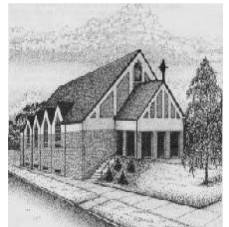
Sisters and brothers, we are filled by God's Spirit, and we are commissioned to be Christ's hope—that means we are called to be Christ's people for the world.
