Family Promise's goal is to keep families together by giving families a hand-up and assist them in their return to self-sufficiency. Services include case management, counseling, enrichment programs, resources, and job referrals with the focus on securing employment and next-step housing.

As such, the **Family Promise** ministry is not necessarily an answer to an over-crowded homeless shelter. Participant families are thoroughly screened and must meet certain criteria for this type of assistance, particularly that they are a family with children (with or without two parents) in Newton or Rockdale counties.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

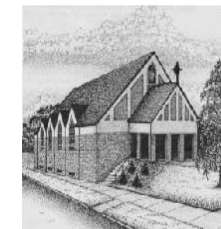
