Presbyterian Village Field Trip!

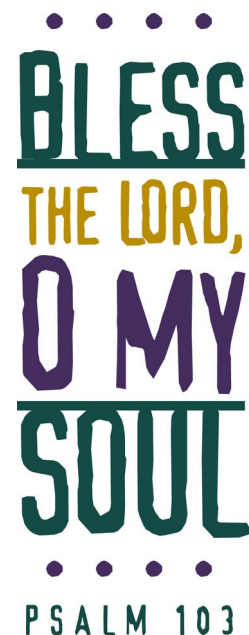

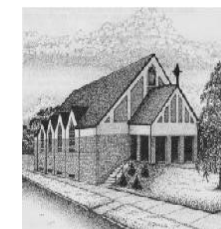

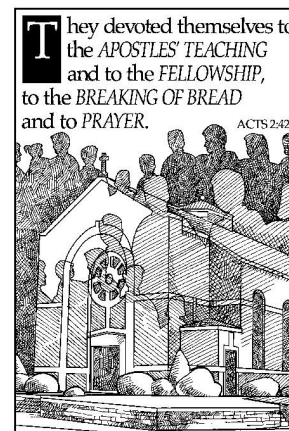
