Then the system will walk you through entering your bank or credit card information. If you did not make a pledge you can choose another fund such as "Non-pledge"; or "Mother's Day", etc. There is a drop-down menu you can scroll through to choose a fund.

Other ways to give:

You may continue to give by mailing checks to the church, dropping your offering in our mailbox (open the box and drop it in, then close the box, or by giving on-line.

To use Realm visit <https://tinyurl.com/fpcgiving>

1. Log-in with your email and password
2. When your page opens click on "Giving" on the left-side menu
3. At the top click on +giving tab
4. Fill out form with amount and fund (you can change it to any fund by clicking on the menu arrow)
5. If you pledge you need it to say "2020 pledge"; or "non-pledge" or choose another fund (i.e. flowers or food pantry)
6. Click continue when you've filled out that page;
7. On the next page you can choose a credit card or bank; continue to put in account information (you can set up an auto pay for weekly or monthly)

After you complete that the program leads you into clicking through the process and then "finish"

Special Monday—Volunteer with the First United Methodist Food Pantry June 1st Emergency COVID Distribution

We have an exciting opportunity on Monday, thanks to the Atlanta Community Food Bank. We are receiving a large donation of fresh fruits, vegetables, and milk to distribute to the community (much like a Mobile Food Pantry) on the morning of June 1st. The food will serve approximately 250 families, and this is a great way to help provide nutritious food in a time when many families in our community are facing food insecurity. To do this undertaking, we need you help! The volunteer jobs are similar to our Mobile Food Pantry, and we will be outside (rain or shine) on our feet the entire time. [The sign up page is here.](#) Police officers will manage street traffic, volunteer jobs are split into registration, food distribution/loading vehicles, and traffic. We have more registration volunteers, since we will be processing registrations like our regular food pantry (screening photo IDs, getting household information, etc.) All volunteers will be asked to help with set up and tear down of tables, signs, trash, cardboard, etc.

We will provide light breakfast and a boxed lunch for volunteers, and we will have water and Gatorade available to keep everyone hydrated. Volunteers are required to wear masks and gloves (we will provide if needed), and volunteers should be in the low risk category for serious complications from COVID19 and should not reside with someone at high risk. This would be a great group activity for a family, scout group, or work group. Let me know if you have any questions, and please do sign up if you are able to help!
